

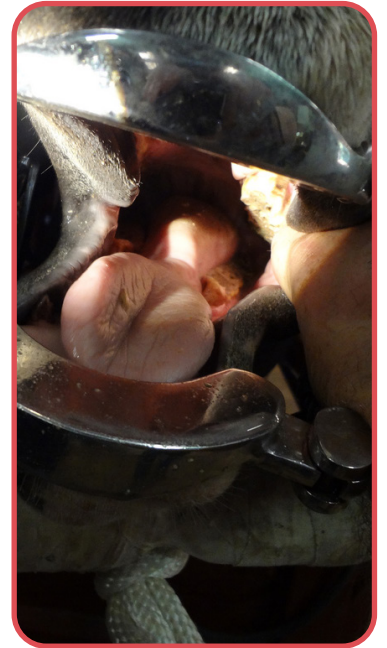
Standing Surgery, Dental Extractions and Head Shaking
